REDEVELOPMENT

The latest figures report the completion of our project at 33%!
Currently, Roof Joist Erection is complete and decking is now being installed. Mechanical and Electrical rough-ins are ongoing on the ground, second, and third floors. Further, coring through the concrete floors for plumbing has commenced. Finally, Exterior boarding has been completed on the first, second, and third floors; the fourth will be complete soon. Although we are currently a bit behind schedule, plans to make up construction progress are underway.
