OUTBREAK

REDEVELOPMENT

The last remaining item on the superstructure of the building is the penthouse, and it is nearing completion. Steel stud framing on the first floor has been completed, and the remaining floors are underway.

Mechanical and electrical rough-ins are progressing throughout the building. Additionally, the roofing membrane is being installed along with the fireproofing spray throughout the floors.

The project is falling farther behind schedule, and the General Contractor is working on mitigation plans to reduce the overage.
