Dear Residents, Families, and Staff,



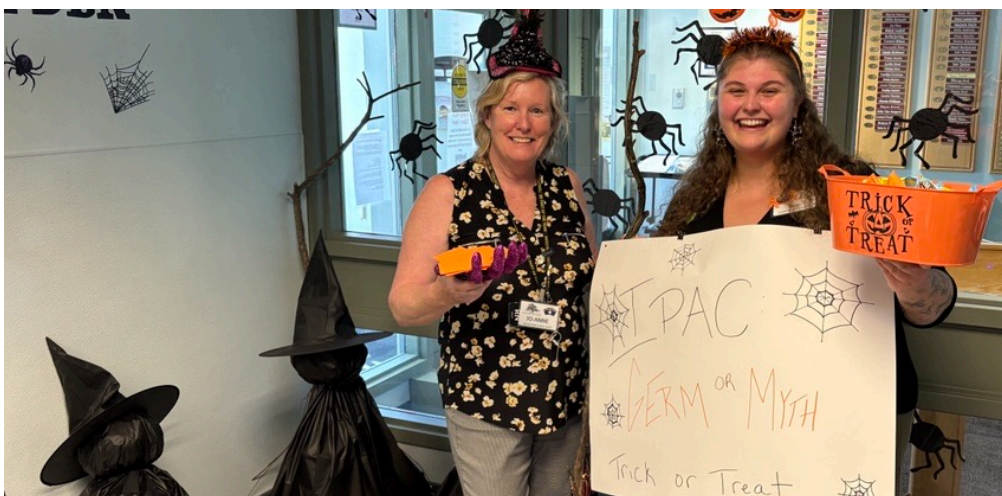
Thank you for being part of our vibrant community. We look forward to celebrating with you soon!

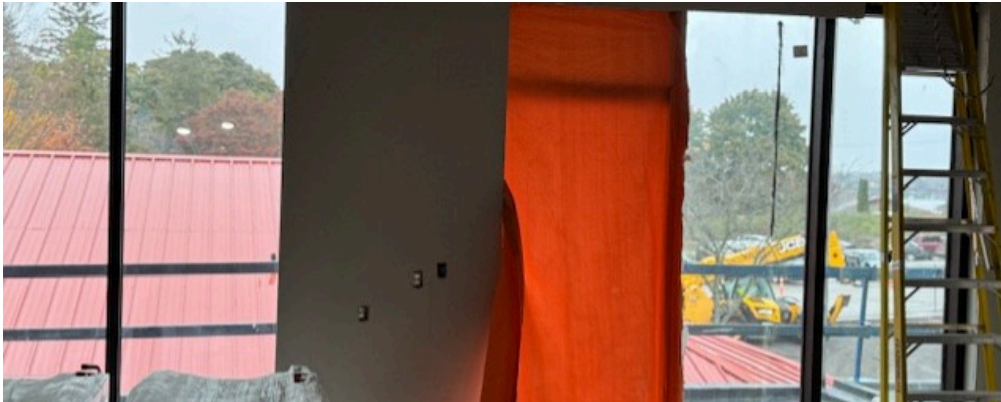


We would like to offer a huge thank you to the wonderful folks at Bethel Christian Reform Church have graciously donated shawls and quilted lap blankets for residents.
