NEW YEAR GREETING

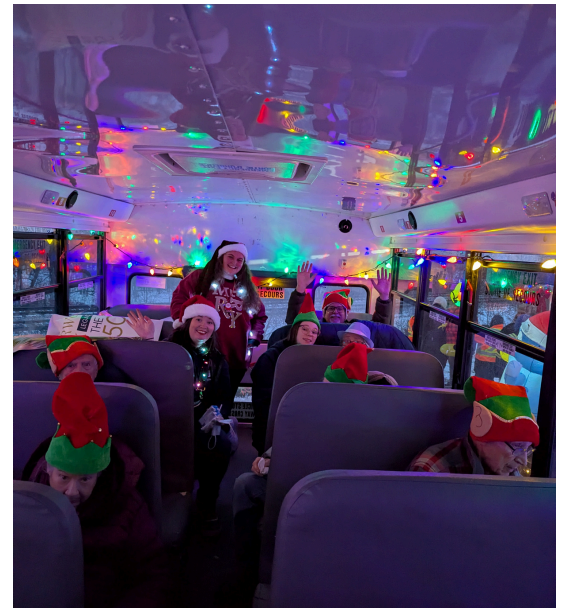
Happy New Year to families, staff, and residents!

Sherwood Park Manor has been named a finalist for the 2026 Canadian Choice Award.

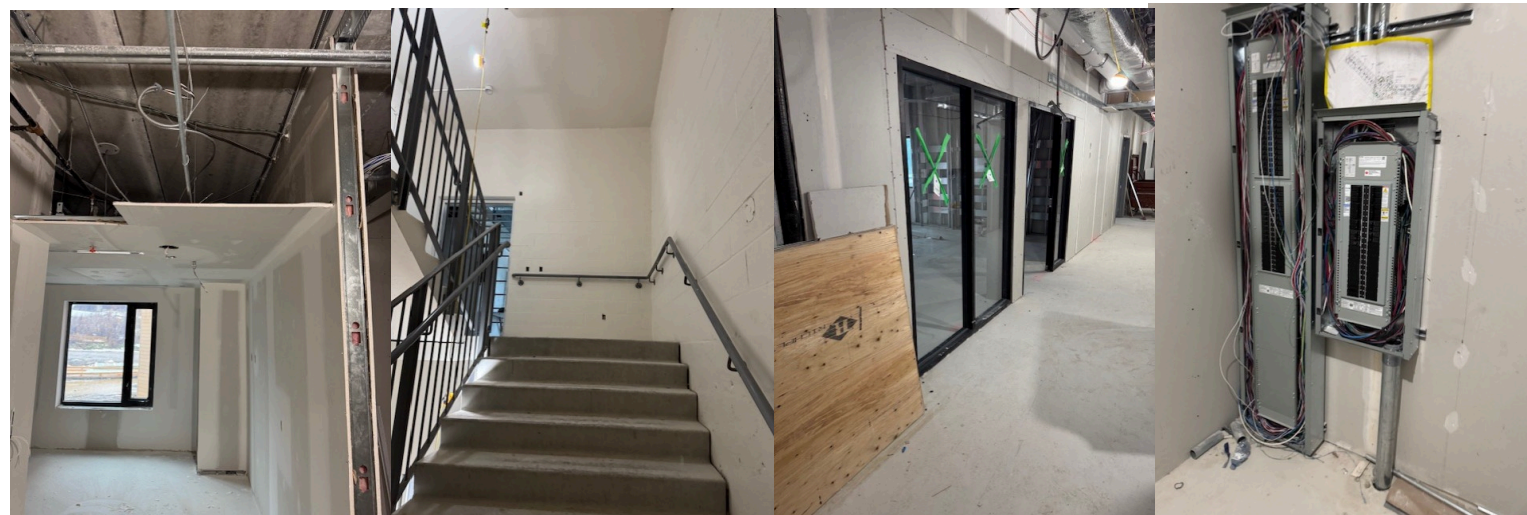
INSPIRING NEWS
